Arthur Schopenhauer (/ ˈ ʃ ʊ p ə n h ə ʊ . ə r / SHOH-pən-how-ər; German: [ˈaɐ̯tʃʊə ˈʃoːpənhaʊ̯ɐ]; 22 February 1788 – 21 September 1860) was a German philosopher. He is best known for his 1818 work *The World as Will and Representation* (expanded in 1844), wherein he characterizes the phenomenal world as the product of a blind and insatiable metaphysical will.

The World as Will and Representation (WWR; German: *Die Welt als Wille und Vorstellung*, WWV) is the central work of the German philosopher Arthur Schopenhauer. The first edition was published in 1818/1819, the second expanded edition in 1844, and the third expanded edition in 1859. In 1948, an abridged version was edited by Thomas Mann.
