Semantic Analogies. Semantic analogies are word usage analogies that emphasize the similarity or difference of word definitions. An example of a synonym analogy could be peace: harmony, meaning that peace is similar to harmony. An antonym analogy could be straight: curved, emphasizing that straight is the opposite of curved.
